

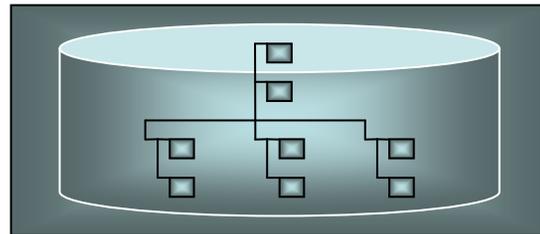

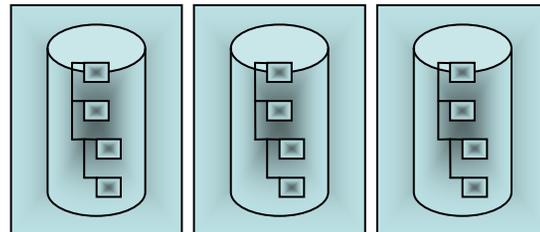

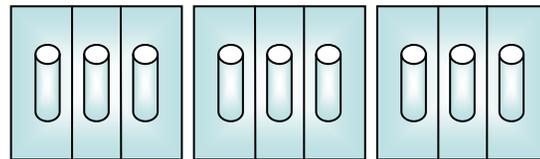
Interoperability

Rationale for Semicolon

- Full interoperability is highly prioritised in Norway
 - 'An Information Society for All', Report no 17 (2006-2007) to the Storting
- Norwegian public sector is increasingly user-oriented, aiming at the provision of electronic services on a 24/7 basis
- General goal: Citizens and businesses should report information only once and thus make life easier for citizens and businesses
- EU's Lisbon strategy claims that a good public sector represents a competitive advantage for businesses
- Collaboration between public organisations, citizens and businesses is necessary to provide a more effective and efficient public sector
- Semicolon will realise collaborative activities that would not have been possible to accomplish within existing relations between the individual organisations

Semicolon

Main goal:

Develop and test ICT-based **methods, tools and metrics** to obtain faster and cheaper semantic and organisational interoperability both with and within the public sector.

Characteristics of Semicolon

- Consortium is multidisciplinary: expertise in semantics, object orientation, organisational development
- Identification of obstacles in real cases of collaboration
- Allow differences between collaborating organisations (e.g. values, goals, and aspects of the same concept)
- Participating public organisations are locomotives for a more effective and efficient public sector
- Development activities based on prototypes/demonstrators, and verification in real collaboration cases
- Dissemination of findings and results to national and international recipients
